What we ask of you...

- A maximum of 25 people attending, which includes the couple, witnesses and guests. It also includes any workers who are not employed by the church such as photographers.
- Names and telephone numbers of all those attending to be provided in advance of the wedding date for NHS Test and Trace purposes
(In line with guidance issued by the Department for Health and Social Care, we will keep your details safely and in compliance with GDPR legislation for 21 days before securely disposing of or deleting them. We will only share your details with NHS Test and Trace, if asked, in the event that it is needed to help stop the spread of coronavirus. We will not use your details for any other purposes or pass them on to anyone else)
- List of who belongs to which household and/or bubble, to allow us to plan the seating in church. This includes all those in the bridal party.

For the safety of yourself and others...

- Please observe the necessary physical distancing requirements.
- All those attending are strongly advised to wear a face covering unless, and in line with government guidance, you have a legitimate reason not to do so. Please note however that they are not a replacement for physical distancing and regular hand washing.
- Regular cleaning of the church and hand sanitiser provided.
- Careful hygiene practices by the minister leading the service.
- If service sheets are used we ask that you please take them away after the service.
- Please avoid touching surfaces unnecessarily during your visit.
- Please do not attend if you have symptoms of COVID-19 or are feeling unwell.
- Please take note of Government advice if you are in a vulnerable category.
